Seven asterisked clues require thematic adjustment before they can be solved fully and correctly.

Clues are presented in an order determined by grid position of the first letter of the solution. One solution is a prefix, and another an abbreviation.

Solvers should highlight our hero as he appears in the grid. 2018 Sirius

Clues directed di have diametric solutions usually running along a diameter from the number indicated on one side of a dial, through the centre to the other side of the dial. The direction Adi indicates that the diametric entry concerned takes the shortest route and does not pass through the centre.

Clues directed $\mathbf{C}$ are circular, running from the number around the dial in a clockwise direction. On occasions, AC indicates an anti-clockwise direction.
Clues directed d have conventional down solutions. Those directed 'up' start from a number and run upwards.
The purpose of the colours in the grid is just to guide the eye.
