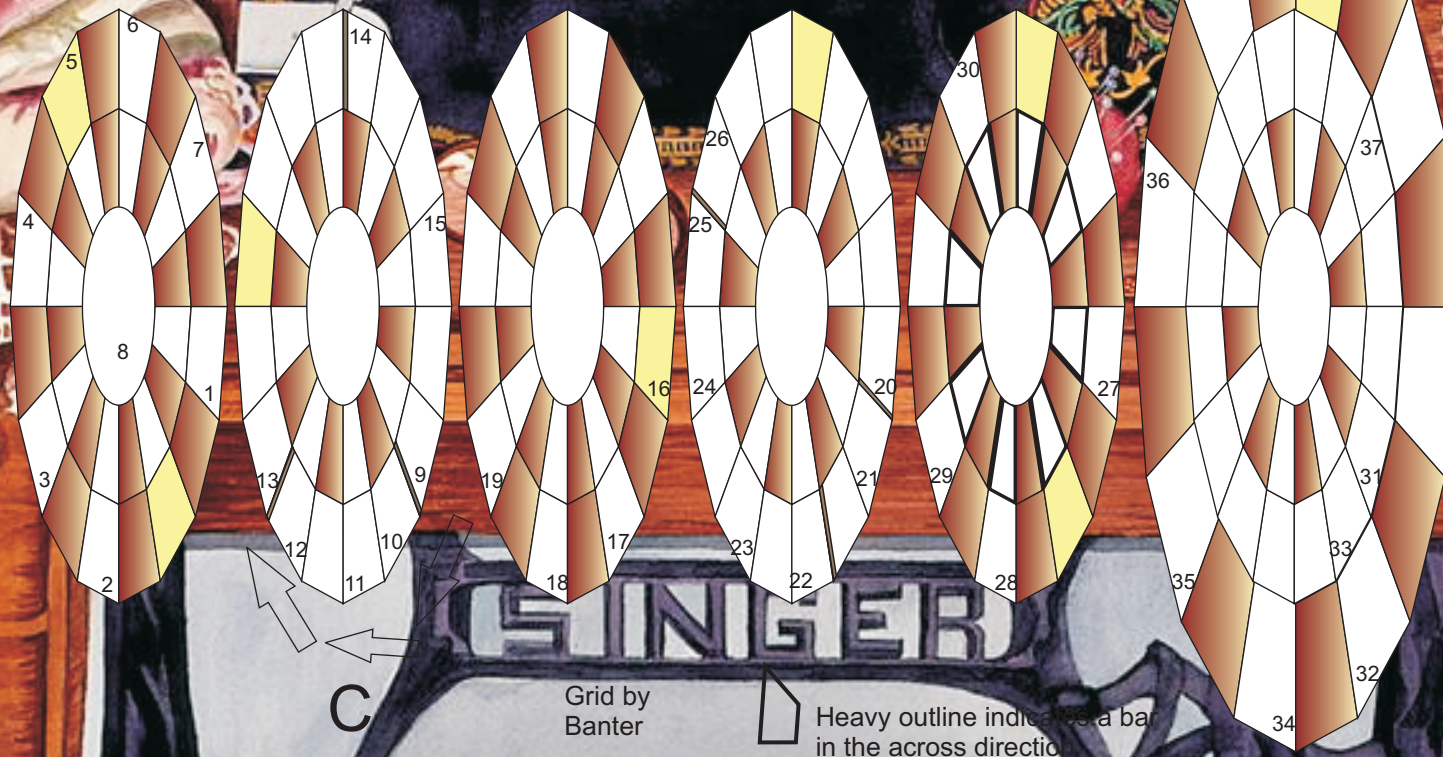

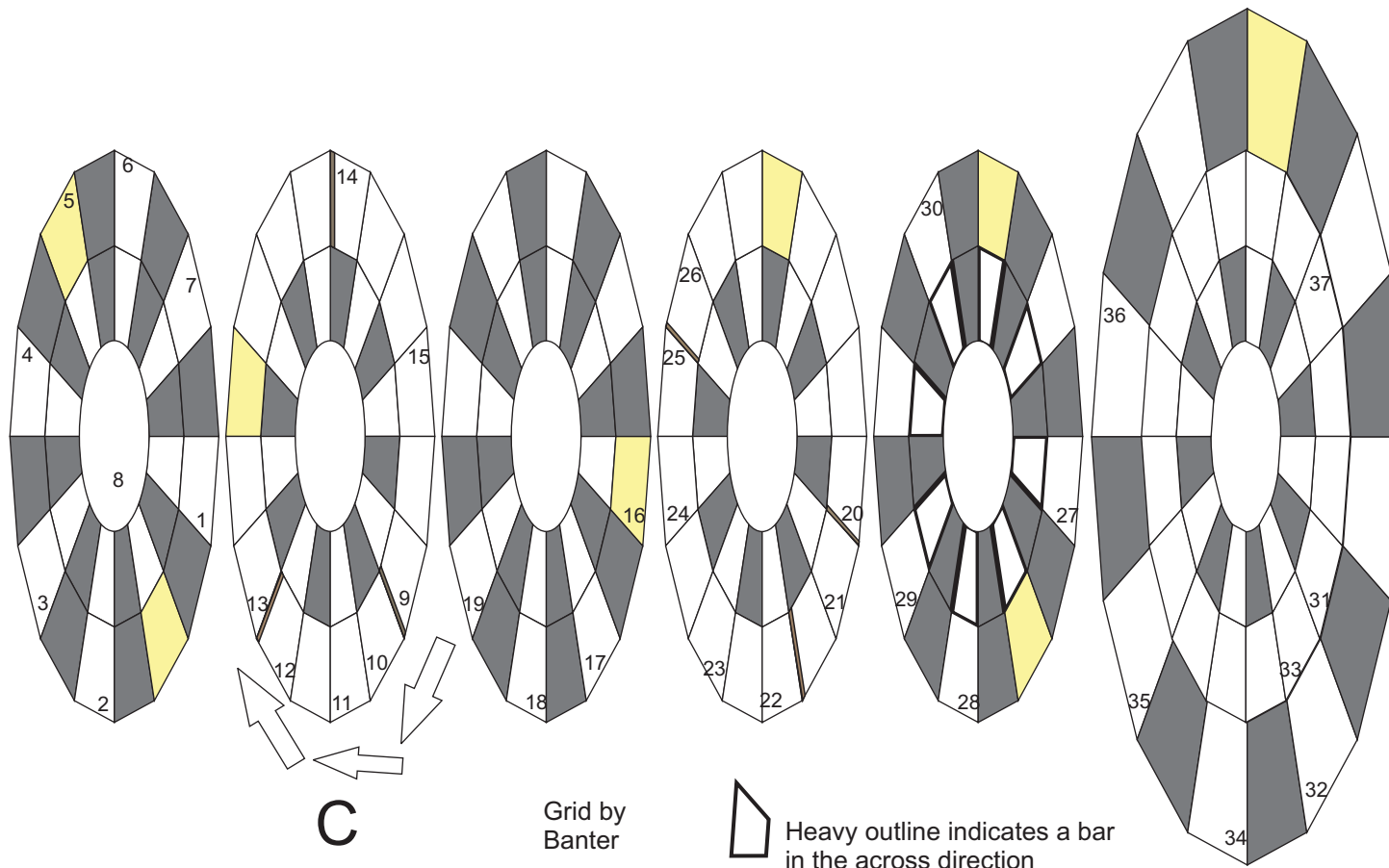

Across solutions are conventional.

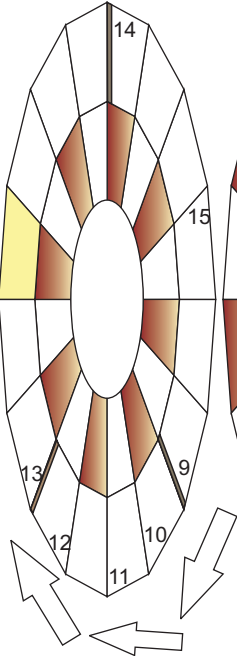
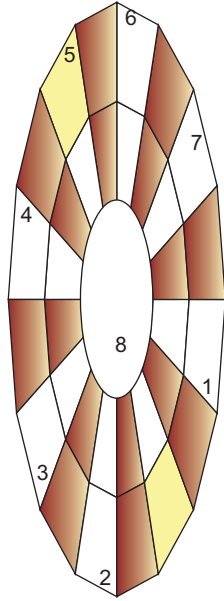
